Esarey, a Private of Captain John Connally's Company (G) 53rd Regiment of Indiana Infantry Volunteers who was enrolled on the 27th day of Sept. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five to serve for one year or during the war, is hereby DISCHARGED from the service of the United States, thirty-first day of May 1865, at Washington, D. C. in compliance with Par. 4 G.O. No. 94 War Dept. 1865. (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.) Said John C. Esarey was born in Perry County in the State of Indiana, is 22 years of age, 5 ft. 9-1/2 in. high. Fair complexion. Blue eyes, light hair, and by occupation when enrolled, a Farmer. Given at Near Washington, D. C.
